Tips for Reading at Home

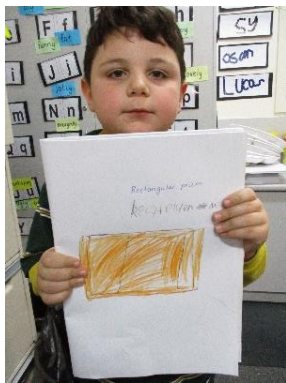

QUIZ NIGHT Sat 3 June in Bradman School Gym

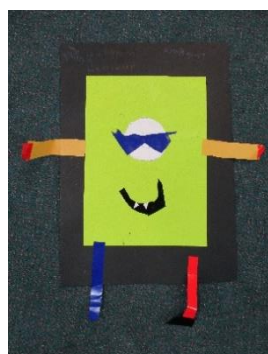
